Notes:

- 1) The course is accurately measured with a Jones Counter and certified. It is comprised of 4, 5, 8 or 10 laps of a 10 kilometre circuit (BC-2023-003a- TBD) with an additional 467.20 metres extension lap for those doing the 50 Mile distance (BC-2026- TBD).
- 2) This 39th edition of the race saw a beautiful calm dry mainly sunny day with temperatures from 12–18°C.
- 3) Forty-four (44) participants Registered for the 2026 event across the four divisions, forty (40) started, and thirty-seven (37) Finished their registered distance within the official 12-hour time limit.
